O. 914 (II)/99.—In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of Rule 3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973, the following method, qualifications and other conditions are laid down for appointment to the under-mentioned posts in the Population Census Organization under the Ministry of Finance, Economic Affairs and Statistics:—

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QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

4. A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age limits as mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule to this Notification. In these Rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context:---

- (i) "Experience" means the experience gained in a regular full time paid job after obtained the prescribed basic qualifications. ✓
- (ii) The period spent by a candidate in obtaining degree of M. Phil or Ph.D. in the relevant field shall be treated as practical experience upto a maximum period of two and four years respectively for the purpose of initial appointment, provided that: ✓
 - (a) A candidate who has obtained the degree of M. Phil or Ph.D. during service shall not be entitled to a double benefit of counting the said period as service towards experience prescribed for the post; and ✓
 - (b) This concession shall not be available for the post for which the prescribed qualification is M. Phil or Ph.D. ✓
- (iii) Maximum age limit shall be relaxed in respect of the candidates specified, and to the extent indicated in the initial appointment to civil posts (Relaxation of upper age limit) Rules, 1993, as amended from time to time. ✓
- (iv) Eligibility of candidates shall be reckoned as on the closing date fixed for submission of applications in accordance with the Recruitment Rules and the Instructions issued by the government and the Federal Public Service Commission from time to time.

QUALIFICATIONS/CONDITIONS FOR TRANSFER

5. Appointments by transfer shall be made by selection from amongst the persons holding appointment under the Government on a regular basis in the same basic pay scale or equivalent to or identical with the post to be filled provided the person concerned possesses the qualifications/experience prescribed for initial appointment or promotion to the post concerned.

PROBATION

6. Persons appointed by initial appointment or promotion or transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded or if considered necessary it may be
